



# Rules and Regulations

Please read the following carefully before signing and returning your Entry Form

## The Event

1. It is not a Race! It is a Road Trip organised and promoted to benefit St. Barnabas House hospice. It is understood that each team shall use their best endeavours to reach their target of £2000. Raising money for the nominated charity is a condition of entry.
2. The event name and logo cannot be reproduced without the explicit prior consent of the organisers.
3. The charity's name and logo cannot be reproduced without the explicit prior consent of the charity.
4. The organisers reserve the right to decline acceptance of an application for participation, DRIVERS AND VEHICLES.
5. Minimum age requirement for all participating drivers is 21 years. Younger persons may participate only if accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.
6. As at 03/05/2010 the team vehicle must be over 10 years of age to qualify for entry.
7. Both front doors of each participating vehicle are reserved for displaying official Road Trip decals and must be kept free of advertising and sponsors messages.
8. All drivers and co-drivers must fully comply with the European Highway Code to include all legally required spares parts. (Warning triangle, various bulb selections etc.). Drivers must on request be able to present original copies of both parts of their driving licences – log book – car insurance certificate – MOT certificate – Green Card. Continental breakdown cover, personal and medical insurance cover is also highly recommended.
9. All vehicles must pass the official scrutinising and document check prior to being admitted to the event. Failure to comply with any part of clause 8 and 9 will result in non participation in the event and in such cases no compensation or refunds will be given to defaulting teams or individuals.
10. At the organisers discretion, irresponsible driving and/or behaviour may result in immediate expulsion from the event. The organisers decision is final.

## Payment and Cancellation

11. The entry fee includes: return ferry crossing for car and passenger(s), official decals, campsite fees and administration costs.
12. The entry fee is £150 per person, - this must be paid in full at the time of application to the Road Trip.
13. Cancellation must be made in writing together with full account of all sponsorship received. In the event of cancellation or non-participation your deposit will not be refunded but donated in full to the charity.
14. All funds received must be paid directly to the Hospice Road Trip Office. Cheques are made payable to the Hospice Road Trip.

## Liability

15. The organisers cannot accept responsibility for any vehicle or personal loss howsoever incurred.
16. The organisers cannot accept responsibility for any additional costs incurred by participants as a result of weather, closure of ports, industrial action, vehicle breakdown, lost or stolen personal belongings, fines and penalties incurred on the event for whatever reason. If any such events occur the organisers will endeavour to act in the best interests of all participants.
17. The organisers reserve the right to amend the itinerary location or services, as they shall in their absolute discretion deem necessary.
18. It is understood that the signature(s) on the entry form signifies understanding, acceptance and compliance with all above Rules & Regulations, by ALL persons named on the entry form.
